Textological Works of XIX Century Georgia

Publishing activities in Georgia developed at a very slow pace until the 70s of the 19th century. However, the rise of national self-awareness has increased the interest of the Georgian people in their own history, in general, in public ideas. The publication of literary and historical monuments began.

At the end of the 80's, the "Georgian Publishing Partnership" was established, the purpose of which was to publish and popularize monuments of modern and ancient Georgian literature.

Prominent Georgian textologists of the 19th century are Davit Chubinashvili, a professor at the University of St. Petersburg, and Petre Umikashvili, who collected manuscripts, compared them with each other, chose a complete, reliable text, and added biographies and notes.
